Jimmie Davis Bridge (LA 511)																	\$361 million Jimmie Davis Bridge Replacement (LA 511). Major work underway on both the new 4-lane bridge itself, as well as the widening and realignment of the LA 511 roadway approaches to the bridge in Shreveport and Bossier City. 5% Estimated completion mid to late 2027
I-20 Rehabilitation																	The \$128 million consists of a complete reconstruction of all the travel lanes and on/off ramps at five interchanges from Benton Road to Industrial Drive in Bossier City and pannel & joint replacements in Caddo Parish. 92% complete. Estimated completion late2025/early 2026
LA 3132 (Inner Loop) Extension																	FONSI Issued. NLCOG has programed \$1 million to begin ROW mapping. DOTD propped agreement with Red River Expressway Toll project for development of their project.
I-20 Passenger Rail																	FRA granted \$500,000 as part of the Corridor Identification and Development Program and \$400,000 from the Interstate Rail Compacts (IRC) grant program for the I-20 Corridor Intercity Passenger Rail Service towards development of a train service that will connect Shreveport, Ruston and Monroe to Dallas, Texas. AMTRAK approved location of Shreveport Terminal at SporTran City.
